Even though it is slightly smaller than the T32, the T30.1 gets top marks for storage and head room, and comfortably fits even a larger crew. Targa's outstanding practicality is also in full evidence in the T30.1 – there is a place for everything and everything is in its place.



TRUSTWORTHY AND RELIABLE. The T30.1 is built with complete safety and seaworthiness in mind. In fact, the incredibly solid hull design provides superior handling in rough seas with no let down in comfort, while enhanced soundproofing ensures a quiet journey even at high cruising speeds.

The T30.1 also offers good fuel efficiency for a boat in its category. You can choose a single 380 horsepower engine or go all the way up to twin engines with a total of 640 horsepower.

FLYBRIDGE. Experience the potent performance of Targa with a taste of salt.

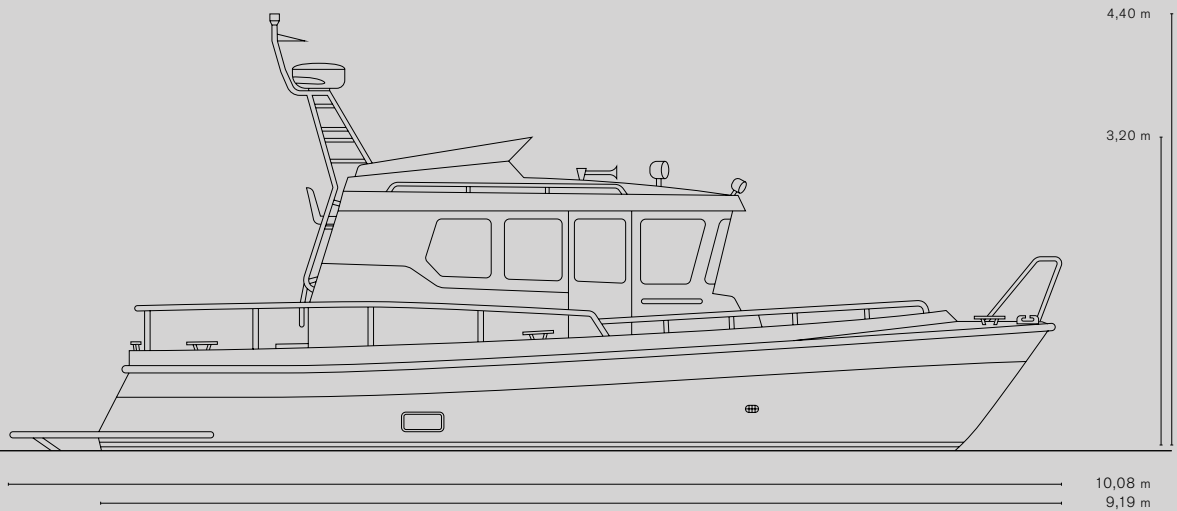

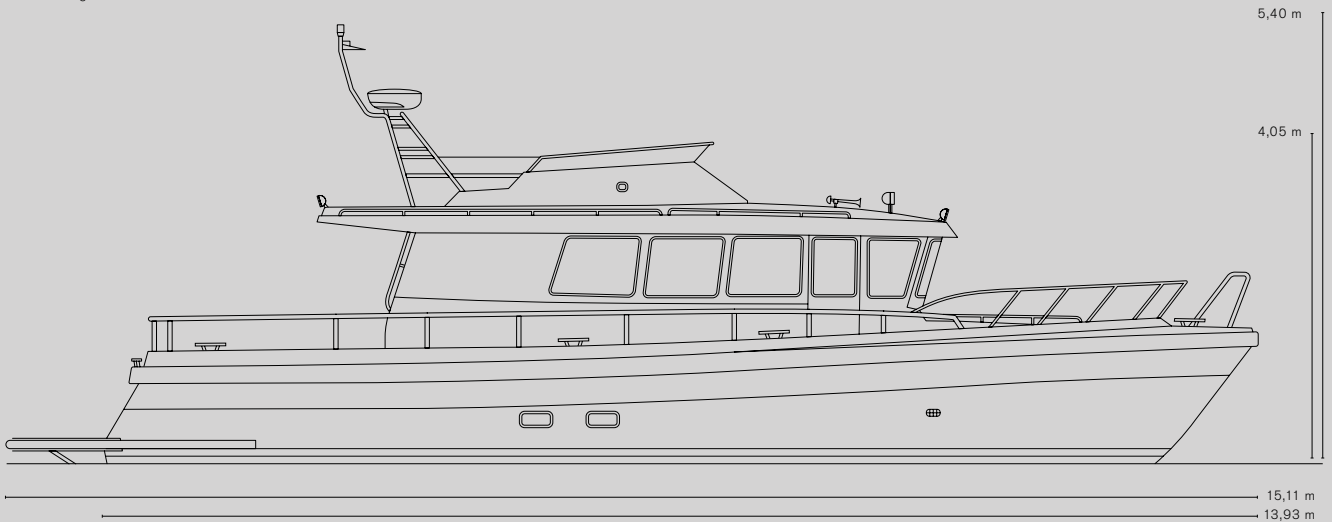
